- 1. Show management reserves the right to cancel, combine or split classes.
- 2. Judge's decisions are final, judges will be following Colorado 4-H rules.
- 3. Hobby Horse Farms management reserves the right to excuse any horses deemed dangerous or out of control. HHF also reserves the right to ask any horse or rider deemed dangerous to leave show grounds.
- 4. No loose dogs allowed on the show grounds, No dogs in the buildings.
- 5. Hobby Horse Farms Open Winter Buckle series is open to all breeds, ages and disciplines.
- 6. Professionals are welcome in OPEN classes only. AQHA Rules apply for amateur eligibility.
- 7. Show series will follow the current 4-H rule book.
- 8. Stallions may not be shown by any person under the age of 18 years.
- 9. Exhibitors will be given 3 Gate calls (gate will be held at maximum of one minute) before gate will be closed. No refunds will be issued for missed classes once gate is closed.

10. Apparel

A. English:

Rider – Boots, long pants, shirt, hunt coat, and hunt cap or helmet required (Approved equestrian helmets required for any over-fence classes).

Horse - Colorado 4-H rules apply for legal tack

B. Western:

Rider – Boots, long pants, long sleeve shirt, western hat or helmet required (No rider shall receive penalty for riding in an approved equestrian helmet).

Horse – Colorado 4-H rules apply for legal tack. Junior horses may ride in snaffle, one handed bit or Bosal. Senior horses must be one handed, in shanked bit.

- 11. Walk/Trot classes are based on horse/rider combo and may not cross enter into walk/ trot/canter or walk/jog/lope classes.
- 12. Open classes are open to all exhibitors including; youth, adult, professionals.
- 13. Hunter Hack is an over fences class:
 - A. Jumps will be set a 2' vertical fence, Two fences.
 - B. Approved equestrian helmets required for over fences classes
 - C. A 10 minute over fences warm up will be offered to Hunter Hack participants

14. Ranch Riding:

A. Hobby Horse Farms will not fault riders with or without silver tack, embellished clothing, banded or braided manes, and tail enhancements. We recognize exhibitors may want to show in all classes, so riders will not be faulted based on attire.

15. Awards

- A. Ribbons to placing 1-6 in each class except for training classes
- B. Daily High point offered to: 13 & Under, 14 18, 19 & Over, Open
- C. Ties will be broken first by Showmanship and second by Equitation/Horsemanship.
- D. Year-end trophy buckle awards will be awarded to high point participants.
- E. Year-end buckles will be awarded to exhibitors with the most points who attended all four shows in the series.
